In this role, Brenda provides leadership and oversight for Fraser Health's annual operating budget of over \$3.4 billion and is responsible for all strategic planning, budgeting and financial services. Throughout her tenure with Fraser Health, Brenda has demonstrated exceptional fiscal leadership despite the immense challenges faced within the public health care system. With a rapidly growing population and increased demand for services, Brenda admirably juggles competing demands for scarce resources while delivering a balanced budget as required by Government.

Brenda's professional relationship with Fraser Health dates back to 1984. Over the past three decades, she has held progressively senior positions in the organization's finance department. She holds a deep knowledge of Fraser Health's corporate and financial histories and has detailed experience from all sectors in the organization. Brenda is also actively involved in the Fraser Health communities, working directly with eleven hospital and health care foundations to align their fundraising activities with Fraser Health's capital priorities. She engages with her CFO colleagues from all Western Canadian healthy authorities to share knowledge and discuss emerging health care trends through the Western CFO forum. Brenda is a Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA, CMA) and has a Master of Arts degree in Leadership and Training from Royal Roads University.
