Nancy is a professional corporate director, and former financial executive, with experience in heavy industrial, manufacturing and service organizations, financial institutions, investment management and higher education. Having provided strong leadership at the Board and CFO level in privately-held, cooperative, not-for-profit and Crown entities, Nancy has a breadth of experience in an array of diverse and complex operating environments with specific experience leading strategic planning and execution, team leadership, creating culture, risk management, operational excellence, governance, restructuring and acquisitions/divestitures.

She is currently Chair of the Board of Governors at the University of British Columbia, Vice Chair and Chair of the Risk Committee at Coast Capital Savings Federal Credit Union and a board member on other public and private company boards. Nancy has previously served on many community, association and pension boards, including chairing Audit, Finance, Governance and Nominations committees. During her executive career at Seaspan ULC, she was an instrumental part of the executive team that pursued and won the National Shipbuilding Program to revitalize the shipbuilding sector on the West Coast, generating billions in economic impact for BC and creating thousands of long term sustainable jobs. As a board member she is passionate about both people and performance, advocating for inclusive workplaces, values-based decision making and accountability.

She served the CPA profession for many years, supporting students to achieve their designations. Her contributions included exam support, tutoring, course instruction and exam authorship, as well as exam marking for both provincial and national associations. She gives back to her community through volunteerism, and has been team manager and other support roles for community soccer and hockey clubs, as well as Host Chair for the BC Hockey 2018 Midget Provincial Hockey Championships. In 2019 she was on the BC Women's Health Foundation GLOW Gala committee, which raised over \$1.8M for the BC Provincial Milk Bank expansion project, supporting the Province's most vulnerable moms and babies.

Nancy holds an Honours Bachelor of Business Administration from Wilfrid Laurier University (Waterloo) and is a Chartered Professional Accountant (CA). She was elected to Fellowship by the Chartered Professional Accountants of BC (2018) and has completed the Institute of Corporate Directors DEP program, obtaining her Corporate Director Designation (ICD.D).
